Caroline County now has Drager Air monitors for Engines & Squads

ALL Engines now have a Drager 4 gas air monitors.

Gases: Methane Oxygen, Hydrogen Sulfide, Carbon Monoxide

Location: In the Cab and in clear top yellow pelican case

Operation: Turn unit on by pressing green key for 3 seconds.

Alarm will sound, red lights will flash while unit runs a self check.

Display will say "Cal 154" indicating how many days left until calibration.

Monitor will begin testing atmospheric conditions and display information on the screen.

The alarm will sound and red lights flash again if any levels exceed programmed limits.

To turn off, press and hold the green and blue buttons together for 3 seconds.
